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Volkswagen delivers 367,900 CVs in first three quarters

In Western Europe vehicle deliveries increased by 2.6 per cent to 249,500 vehicles. In Italy, vehicle deliveries soared by 11.6 per cent to 9,100 vehicles.

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In Eastern Europe deliveries of the brand increased by 17.1 per cent to 29,000 vehicles.

New Delhi: In the first three quarters of the year, Volkswagen Commercial Vehicles delivered 367,900 vehicles from the T, Caddy, Crafter and Amarok series to customers all around the world. This represents an increase of 4.9 per cent compared with the same period last year.

In Western Europe vehicle deliveries increased by 2.6 per cent to 249,500 vehicles. In Italy, vehicle deliveries soared by 11.6 per cent to 9,100 vehicles.

In Spain the figure spiked by 10.89 per cent to 11,100 vehicles and in France deliveries increased by 9.9 per cent to 15,500 vehicles.

In Germany, deliveries dipped by 0.1 per cent to 91,900 units, and in Great Britain figures slipped by 4.1 per cent to 35,700 units.

In Eastern Europe deliveries of the brand increased by 17.1 per cent to 29,000 vehicles.

In North America (Mexico) deliveries increased by 37.0 per cent with 7,700 units. In South America deliveries increased by 21.9 per cent to 30,600 vehicles, and in the Asia-Pacific region soared by 17.3 per cent to 19,200 vehicles, Volkswagen Commercial Vehicles also delivered more units than in the previous year.

The markets in Africa dipped by 6.9 per cent to 10,300 vehicles, and the Middle East declined by 12.7 per cent to 21,600 vehicles.

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
